Respect Life Month – Begins Next Weekend

At the core of Jesus' Gospel of life and Church teaching is a fundamental belief that all life is sacred. All life is infused with an intrinsic dignity. This comes from all life being made into the image and likeness of God. As Christians, we believe this process begins at the very flashpoint of conception, and we are entrusted with honoring the dignity of each life until natural death. In a life beyond this life, God's love and mercy continues to transform us more and more into God's own perfect image.

The prophets throughout all time have been heralds of life, oracles of truth. These are the voices that cry out to world to end war, division, and violence, to respect the stranger and the vulnerable, to share with and care for the widow, the orphan, and the disadvantaged. As One Church in the mission of Christ's love, we are called to continue this prophetic work, to boldly go before our friends, family, adversaries, and the whole world and announce the reign of Life, the reign of Peace, the reign of unconditional love.

October is a month dedicated to Life. It's a season to celebrate life, to remember why we embrace the dignity of each person even when it is difficult. This is not a month designed to cast judgment or condemnation on those who disagree with the Church's position on life. Instead, we have chosen to pledge our faith to Christ, who never condemned, ridiculed, reviled, or ostracized His opponents. We use this month to reaffirm our own convictions about what we believe about life and human

dignity. We use this time to raise awareness of life issues. We also have a chance to educate ourselves on both sides of positions to life issues, to better understand the challenges encountered by those who are in situations where they must choose death or life.

The unborn child, the death row inmate, the abused, the trafficked women and men caught in the lucrative sex/porn industry, the immigrant, the worker who is denied rights, the person suffering from a disease that relies on stem cell research for a cure, the violence in shows on tv, the terminally ill or severely infirmed elderly considering euthanasia... we are faced with countless decisions about life every minute of every day. What does it mean for you to respect life? To be a member of a faith rooted in life, peace, and the unconditional love of Christ?

Prayer: God of life, mold us, fashion us into Your image and help us to see Your likeness in all the life around us, that we may reverence life in all its forms – at every stage of its existence. Amen.

Action: There are MANY opportunities to observe Respect Life month. Here at Assumption, we will:

- 1) Have a Living Rosary in our chapel at 8:15am on Sat. Oct. 4th – the feast of St. Francis, the patron saint of Peace,
- 2) Participate in the area-wide Life Chain in front of our church and chapel from 2p-3p on Sun. Oct. 5th
- 3) Gather along Mid Rivers Mall Drive in St. Peters (side walk near Barnes & Noble) during Respect Life Month every Friday from 12p – 2p

Through prayer, personal refection, and practice, may we all use the coming weeks to rededicate our lives to a deep, unshakable reverence for LIFE.
