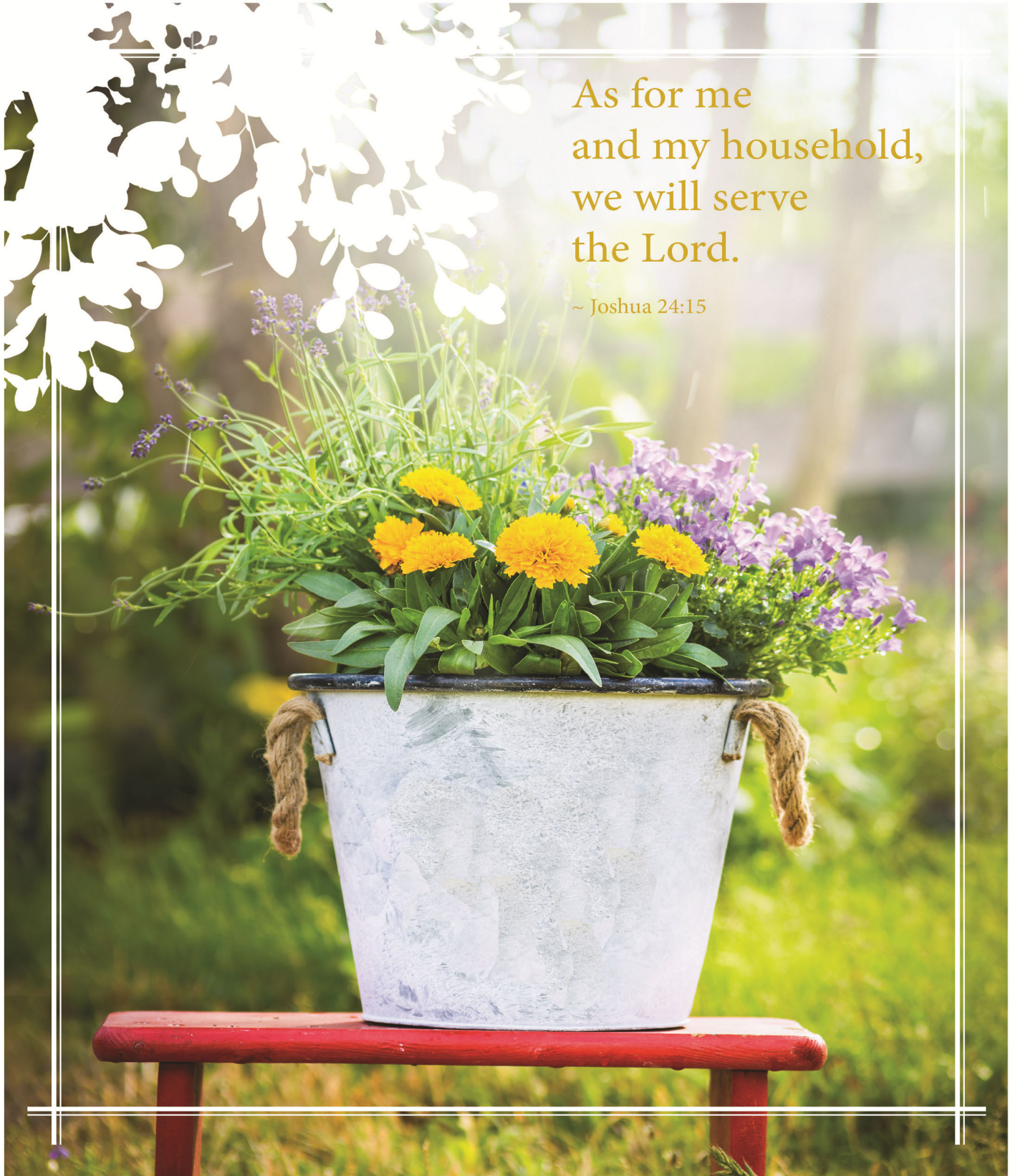

Jesus great prayer for us is “that they all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, that the world may believe that you sent me (Jn. 17:21).” The mission of the Catholic Church is to be a window into the very life of God which is given as pure grace and poured out in all of creation. Through the sacramental life of the Church, especially the Eucharist, we share the communion of saints and eternal life.

On Thursday, August 27, 7:00pm, join us in church as we will have an opportunity to explore “**What We Believe**” by examining the Apostle’s Creed, breaking open the scriptures and sharing our faith journeys with each other. Please join us and help us live this great mission which has been handed on to us by the Apostles.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation) – This is a process whereby individuals who have never been baptized, or have been baptized in another religion, become fully initiated into the Catholic Faith. 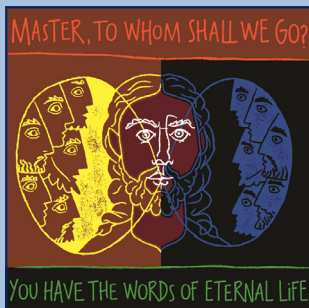

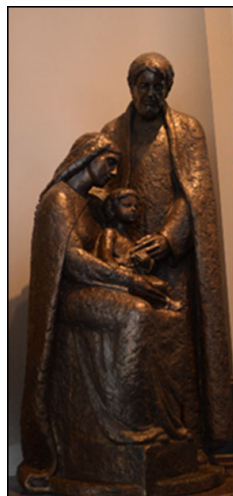

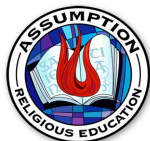

Life, Peace, Justice

Pope Francis enjoins all Christians to join in prayer on September 1, 2015. Come pray with us Tuesday morning, September 1 at our 8am Mass for the Care of Creation.

The ecological crisis, he said, is a summons "to a profound spiritual conversion" and to a way of life that clearly shows we are believers. Quoting his encyclical, he said, "living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to a life of virtue; it is not an optional or a secondary aspect of our Christian experience."

The annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, Pope Francis said, will be a time for individuals and communities to "reaffirm their personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork which he has entrusted to our care, and to implore his help for the protection of creation as well as his pardon for the sins committed against the world in which we live."

"I invoke upon this initiative the intercession of Mary, mother of God, and of St. Francis of Assisi, whose Canticle of the Creatures inspires so many men and women of goodwill to live in praise of the Creator and with respect for creation," he said.

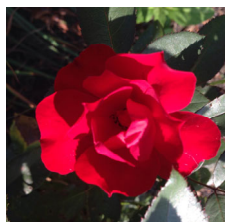

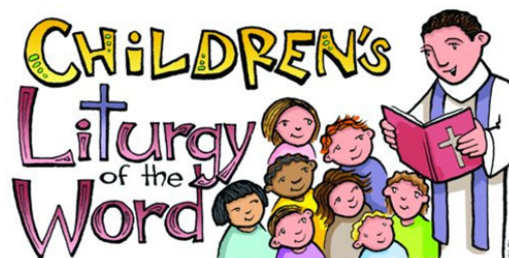
