





Earthquake Devastation in Nepal

Catholic Relief Services (CRS) and Caritas are on the ground responding to the earthquake in Nepal that has left nearly 5,000 dead and thousands more injured. CRS's initial goal is to help 10,000 families with emergency shelter, blankets, water treatment kits, and hygiene kits. Given the scale of the disaster, the number receiving help is expected to rise as our staff and partners are able to better assess the situation, coordinate our response with other agencies and procure additional supplies. CRS has made an initial commitment of \$825,000 to relief efforts in Nepal, a figure that is expected to rise as the needs become clearer.
