Contact Congress on Tax Reform

December 5, 2017

Dear Friends of Religious and Independent Schools,

No matter where you stand on tax reform, members of a House-Senate conference committee are now attempting to reconcile differences between the House and Senate versions of the tax bill, and a few issues of significance to the private school community are at stake:

- 1. Will college savings accounts be expanded to include elementary and secondary education under Section 529 of the tax code?
- 2. Will private schools be able to continue to offer tax-free tuition to the children of teachers and other staff under Section 117(d) of the tax code?
- 3. Will private schools be able to continue to provide up to \$5,250 annually in tax-free educational expenses for employees under Section 127(a) of the tax code?

Please use CAPE's **Legislative Action Center** now to urge members of Congress to intercede with conference committee members to ensure that the final tax reform bill answers the above questions in the affirmative.
