When the weather is cold, and we get snowed in, it can be nice to have so much available online. While we have to worry about the credibility about many things, here are a few websites and apps that I rely on and can be helpful in growing in our faith.



Formed.org This website has an incredible amount of video series and movies and other material for any age. We have used the series ‘The Search and The Wild Goose’ for adult faith here at the parish and I have used ‘Symbolon’ for RCIA meetings in the past, and I know parents who have used numerous ones with their kids. You can register as a parishioner for free and a wide variety of resources are available.

hallow.com Hallow is an app for your phone that not only has the content of various prayers, meditations, devotions, and video clips, (Bible in a year) but also will help you keep a practice of this every day. They have an offer for parishioners of a one-year premium membership for just \$1 at hallow.com/parish and search for “Assumption.”

ibreviary.com/m/breviario.php IBreviary is the first app I used on my phone, and still do today, and the iPhone version was the first iPhone app approved by the Vatican, (I read that online somewhere). It also works for Android phones (what I have), and it offers the daily readings, daily prayers, all the prayers for Mass and other sacraments, many devotions, and other information on it.

catholicsaints.info This site is great for looking up a patron saint, the saint of a day, it even has a section titled “Confirmation Names” (I think that would work for baby names too). It also has links to papal documents, and other information.

catholic-hierarchy.org The Pope just named some new cardinals the other month, who are they and where are they from? You can find it here, (hint—look up consistories). Basically this site gives you very basic information and history about bishops, cardinals, and dioceses throughout the world. No opinions, just the names, dates, places, and statistics.

uscbb.org This is the website for the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. One of the best sites to find the daily Mass readings as well as basic teachings in the Church and some current events and topics.

vatican.va/content/vatican/en.html You can find current and historical Church documents, or where Pope Francis is traveling next, or even the history of the Swiss Guard. It can be useful or interesting just to browse through, and is available in many languages.

vaticannews.va/en.html is the current news service from the Vatican in English. You can see what the most recent stories about the Pope or the Vatican on anything from the LA fires to Ukraine, to new appointments to the Roman Curia.

Of course, there is always the site on everyone’s favorites list, assumptionbvm.org, to find out about our parish or archstl.org to find out about our archdiocese. Hopefully you find some of these apps and websites useful, and might even share them with a friend.

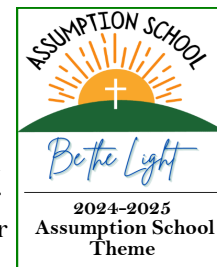

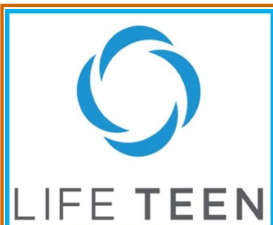
