

RCIA: THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

The RCIA team offer our thanks to all those present for the 8am Masses for the past four Sundays, and our parish community as a whole, who prayed for and with our candidates and our elect during the RCIA Scrutinies. Please continue to pray for our elect and candidates as they enter their final week of preparation for the sacraments of initiation.

As we near the end of the period of Purification and Enlightenment, we see the candidates developing a positive awareness of the baptism they have already received. 
