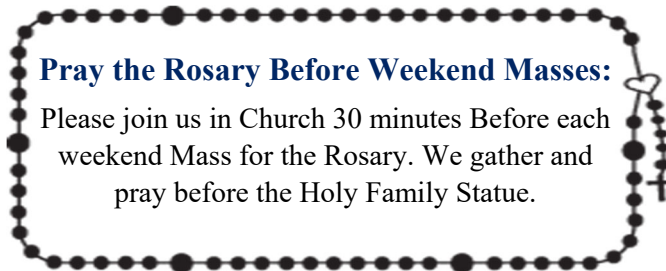

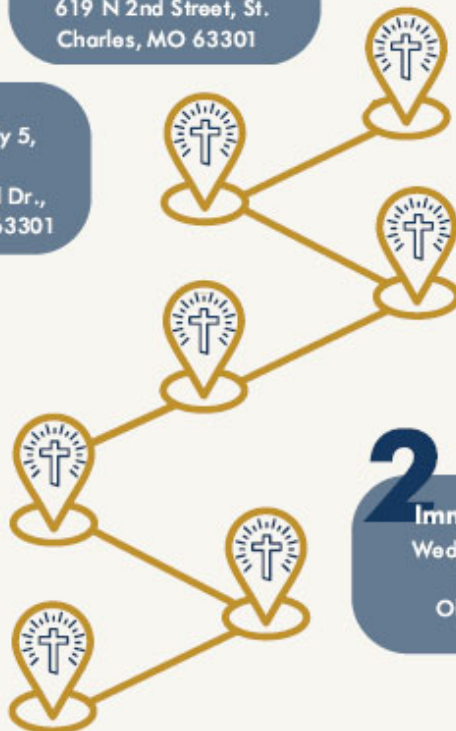

Assumption 2023 "Murder" Court Case – Middle School

Each year, Mrs. Chassaniol creates a "murder" scene, where fingerprints, hair samples, and other clues are left. Each of the Middle School grade levels is tasked with finding the murderer. Each class assigned Prosecuting and Defense Attorneys, Detectives to investigate the crime, and their jury is selected. Once all of the witnesses had spoken to detectives and evidence had been collected, the trial dates were set.

Before the "murder" was set, the students studied the roles of the attorneys – both Prosecuting and Defense. They learned the process for a trial, what taking the "Oath" means, and what a jury and judge are supposed to do. There was also the evidence clerk that held evidence to be used during the trial.

Judge Chassaniol, attended and acted as the Judge on the bench, and explained how trials work and gave instructions to each of the participants. Evidence was presented for both sides and after they have listened to witnesses and the attorneys, the jury was sent out of the court room to decide whether the defendant is guilty as charged.

At each grade level, they selected a different defendant, and each case resulted in the defendant being set free with a "NOT GUILTY". This was a great decision for all three grade levels, as they had NOT chosen the correct person to try.

At the end of the last court case, Mrs. Chassaniol told everyone who the real "murderer" was (Mrs. McHugh) and the crowd erupted, knowing that in each of the three (3) trials, none had brought the correct person to trial. What a great learning experience for our students!

6th GRADE EGYPTIAN PROJECTS

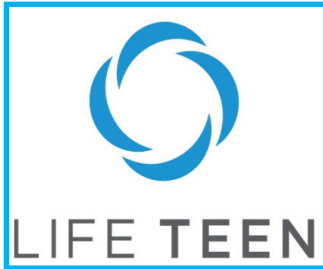
The 6th graders were especially willing to tell me about the Egyptians:

1. **Ancient Egypt** was a civilization in Northeast Africa situated in the Nile Valley. During the course of its history, Egypt was invaded or conquered by a number of foreign powers, including Alexander the Great. After Alexander's death, Cleopatra ruled but the country it fell to the Roman Empire and became a Roman province.
2. The success of ancient Egyptian civilization came partly from its ability to adapt to the conditions of the Nile River valley for agriculture. The predictable flooding and controlled irrigation of the fertile valley produced surplus crops, which supported a more dense population, and social development and culture.
3. The many achievements of the ancient Egyptians include the quarrying, surveying, and construction techniques that supported the building monumental pyramids, temples, and obelisks; a system of mathematics, a practical and effective system of medicine, irrigation systems, and agricultural production techniques, the first known planked boats, Egyptian glass technology, new forms of literature, and the earliest known peace treaty, made with the Hittites.



I was impressed by the knowledge that our students had gained and the projects presented were amazing. The 7th and 8th grade projects will be featured in next weeks bulletin. Congrats to our 6,7, and 8th graders and Mrs. Chassaniol for her awesome teaching!

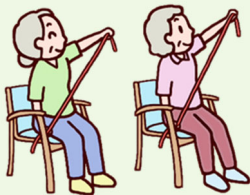

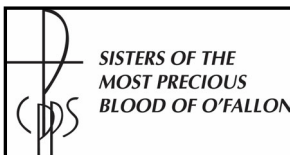
