


With the local parish changes that are going to occur this August 1st with the All Things New initiative I thought I would try and clarify a few things about what is happening to Assumption parish and the difference between a territorial parish and a personal parish.

Most parishes we are used to are territorial parishes. In fact, currently all parishes with churches in the St. Charles deanery are territorial parishes. These parishes have geographical boundaries and were established to serve the people living in those boundaries. Both Assumption and St. Barnabas are territorial parishes. The decree issued by the archbishop will expand the boundaries of Assumption to include all of those people living in what had been St. Barnabas boundaries, and also make any goods, rights, or obligations of St. Barnabas parish to now be a part of Assumption parish. The map below shows the change in the territorial boundaries of Assumption parish.

The new parish being formed called St. Juan Diego Parish is a personal parish. Personal parishes can be established for people of a certain rite, language, nationality, or some other reason. In this case, St. Juan Diego parish is being made a personal parish for those of Hispanic language and heritage. If you speak Spanish and are of Hispanic heritage and live in the archdiocese of St. Louis (the area for which Archbishop Rozanski has responsibility) you can be a member of St. Juan Diego parish.

All property and buildings that were owned by St. Barnabas Parish will be a part of and owned by Assumption parish. But the decrees forming St. Juan Diego Parish and modifying Assumption Parish direct Assumption Parish to lease the land and buildings that were a part of St. Barnabas Parish to St. Juan Diego Parish. The details of this are to be worked out by the pastors of Assumption and St. Juan Diego.

While Assumption (and most other parishes) are considered territorial parishes, that does not mean that you cannot be a part of Assumption if you do not live in our bounda-



ries. A common number I have seen is that around 50% of those registered at a parish live in their boundaries, and about 50% of those living in a parish's boundaries are registered at a different parish. This might be because a family used to live within a parish boundary, then moved somewhere close, but outside of the boundaries. Their children may go to that parish school. Because of friends, relatives, or other reasons they feel more a part of that parish and so registered there and are active there. The pastor is responsible for the people in his parish boundaries and accepts additional responsibility for those who register there. The people are responsible to participate in the sacraments and the Church in various ways, but the people are not required to do so at a particular parish.

We will welcome those who had been a part of St. Barnabas parish, those who live in the territorial boundaries and those who do not. But we also realize that many, particularly those who did not live in the territorial boundaries of St. Barnabas and had chosen to go there will be making a decision of where they choose to go. Please keep all in your prayers, that all find a parish where they can grow in their faith and continue to build up the Body of Christ.



Attention Volunteers Who Work with Children

All those who work, volunteer or coach, in any way, with our children, the vulnerable or elderly at Assumption Parish must be in Compliance with the Archdiocese in order to continue participation in your ministry work. This is **MANDATORY!**

As of December 31st, 2020 the old Virtus system, used to show compliance, has been eliminated. The Archdiocese Safe Environment Program is now using the Prevent and Protect system to very Compliance.

To be in compliance you must register into the Prevent and Protect system where you will submit an updated background check, sign and submit all the Mandatory Reports and Code of Conduct sections. Attending a Protecting God's Children Workshop is also needed to complete Compliance. If you have already completed a Workshop, the information will carry over into the Prevent and Protect system. You will not need to retake the Workshop for your Compliance.
