



### Hello,

This last week we celebrated the first day of summer on June 21st. I always think that seems a little strange since next week is the 4th of July, which feels like the middle of



This was one of the earliest feast days to get set on a particular day since even in Scripture it tells us when it is, "In the sixth month, [since Elizabeth had conceived John] the angel of Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin's name was Mary." (Luke 1:26) So six months after John was conceived, Jesus is conceived, so the births should also be six months apart. The furthest away from Jesus that he could get in a year, or maybe we should look at it as the furthest away from Jesus that we could get, and that is why John is there, to lead us to Christ.

Another one of the classic Scripture quotes regarding John the Baptist that fits this calendar scenario well comes late in John's ministry as Jesus begins his, "He must increase, I must decrease." (John 3:30) As we recognize the longest day of the year was just a few days before John's birthday, and the shortest day of the year just before Christmas. At Christmas the light is coming into the world, Christ. But John, in his humility, while pointing to the light to come considered that it was only his role to direct us to the light, thus he would decrease, just as the days get shorter. Now we don't want to over compare this, but if it can help us to remember Christ, and John the Baptist, and how we need to be focused more on doing God's will than our will, and leading others to Christ instead of being focused on ourselves. That seems like a good thing to be reminded of now and then on a hot summer day.

So I hope we are all enjoying our summer, but let John remind us to not just be focused on ourselves, but also remember, it is only 6 months until Christmas.




