Hello,

This week we celebrated the feast of St. Augustine Zhao Rong, priest and companions, Chinese martyrs. I am often impressed with the different groups of Asian martyrs that consist of some missionaries, and the many local, newly evangelized Christians who were also willing to die for their faith. In this case, in the year 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized 120 Chinese Martyrs who were martyred between 1648 and 1930, with 87 of them being native-born Chinese and 33 foreign-born missionaries.



St. Augustine Zhao Rong's particular situation was that he was a Chinese soldier who was helping to escort a French missionary bishop on a long journey to Beijing for his execution. Along the way, he was impressed with how the bishop acted and started to listen to him. He would soon ask to be baptized and would later ask to be ordained a priest, becoming the first Chinese-born diocesan priest. He would end up being arrested for his faith and die while in prison. These examples not only show us the faith of these individuals, but also how living their faith would affect those around them who would also choose to live this faith, clearly knowing the chance that it might lead them to martyrdom.

While I'm gone on vacation next weekend, we will have a Redemptorist priest, Fr. Andrzej Szorc, share with you some of their missionary work in Argentina and their need for support.

To be in compliance, you must be registered in the Prevent and Protect system where you will submit an updated background check and sign and submit all the Mandatory Reports and Code of Conduct sections. Attending a Protecting God's Children Workshop is also needed to complete Compliance. If you have already completed a workshop, this information will roll over into the Prevent and Protect system and you will not have to redo the workshop for your Compliance.

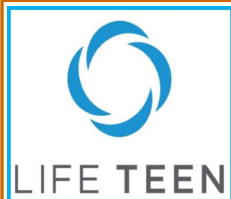

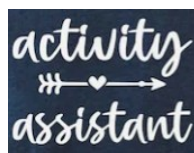
