The Falls Golf Club | Saturday, August 26



FORMATION

Continuous conversion of mind and heart
"Following Jesus is the work of a lifetime"

The RCIA process is now called OCIA, reflecting a closer translation of the process by which adults are initiated into the Catholic faith.

RCIA Initially this was called in English by the acronym RCIA, standing for the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**. It is composed of five distinct periods (evangelization, pre-catechumenate, catechumenate, purification and enlightenment, and mystagogy), marking the progress of an adult converting to the Catholic faith.

However, in November 2021, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops approved a new translation of the name of this process, now calling it **OCIA, the "Order of Christian Initiation of Adults"**.

We have seen this previously with the Rite of Funerals and the Rite of Marriage, which became the Order of Christian Funerals and the Order of Celebrating Matrimony. Likewise, the Rite of Confirmation recently became the Order of Confirmation. The Rite of Infant Baptism, became the Order of Baptism of Children. When the RCIA is retranslated, it will become the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults.

While it may seem like a small change, many see this as a new turning point. According to Meloy for the *Detroit Catholic*, "rites are still part of the order, but **the new structure is meant to invite candidates and catechumens into a continuous process of spiritual formation** as opposed to fixed checkpoints on the path to baptism, first Communion, and confirmation."




