Hello,

The 2024 Paris Olympics are now over, and while rule 50 of the Olympic Charter prohibits any type of religious expression, that isn't always the case. It seemed to start with some religious controversy in the Opening Ceremonies, but on a more positive note, many of the athletes were willing to express their faith in a grateful manner for what God had given them.



The gold medal winner, Novak Djokovic, for men's singles tennis, proudly displayed his Orthodox Christian faith by wearing a cross around his neck throughout the tournament. Then, when interviewed after winning the gold medal, he said God was the key to his success and stated, "I thank God for giving me his mercy, for giving me this blessing and this opportunity."

Brazil's top gymnast, Rebeca Andrade, also gave God credit for her gold medal in the women's floor final, recognizing that it is a combination of God's blessings and our cooperating with those graces. In an interview with CazéTV, Andrade stated: "This medal was not because I asked God for a medal; he gave me the opportunity to win it. I went through everything I had to go through: I worked, I sweated, I cried, I tried hard, I laughed, I had fun, I traveled. So I feel that I made this possible too and he was always there blessing me, protecting me and feeling proud of me, knowing that his servant was always giving her best."

One of the best pictures from the Olympics was of surfer Gabriel Medina (bronze medalist) standing a few feet above the water and pointing his finger in the air with his surfboard standing in the air a few feet behind him after making a great run on a wave, and then letting the wave send him flying into the air. Gabriel shared the photo on his Instagram site with the quote, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." (Philippians 4:13)

The US Team also happened to finish off the Olympics with a Catholic sweep. Both of the flag bearers chosen for the Closing Ceremony for Team USA are Catholic—Katie Ledecky, the most decorated American female Olympian ever, and gold medalist rower Nick Mead. And in case you weren't aware, the Olympic motto, *Citius, Altius, Fortius*, (Faster, Higher, Stronger) was proposed by Pierre de Coubertin when the International Olympic Committee was formed. He borrowed the motto from a Dominican priest, Fr. Henri Didon, who was an athletic enthusiast.

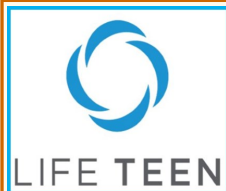


## LOOK WHO GOT CAUGHT GIVING BACK
