

Hello,

A couple weeks ago I mentioned that our Pastoral Strategic Plan (PSP) for Assumption Parish was completed and approved by our Parish Council. It is now also available on our parish website. In my previous article I included our Parish Mission Statement that had been updated to fit our current situation and formed by our visioning meetings and survey results. The rest of the PSP was formed from the strengths and aspirations identified in the visioning meetings and survey results. These were developed into objectives and actions plans by the commissions established to address each focus area.

The following chart summarizes the Strengths and Objectives the visioning meetings and survey results identified. These objectives are a means to assure us there is progress in meeting our goals in the different focus areas of our life as a parish. Action plans have been developed for each of these objectives (and can be found in the PSP). I'm mentioning this because it isn't just a few people on some committees who this will affect; this is meant for our whole parish. Ideally it will be a manner in which we all participate to achieve our goals, growing as a parish and seeing new opportunities to grow in the future.



THE HOLY TRINITY



The central mystery of Faith that is revealed by God alone is the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity. (CCC 261).

Catholics believe that in one God there are three (3) divine Persons—the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

The Trinity is One. We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three Persons. (CCC 253)

June 12 - Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

PRV 8:22-31; PS 8: 4-9; ROM 5:1-5; JN 16: 12-15

Today we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. What we are commemorating is a central reality of our Christian faith, that God is Trinitarian in nature — three distinct persons in one God.

The Church calls this truth a mystery, as indeed it is. Some have said that *“mystery”* in this context is *“not a wall to run up against but an ocean in which to swim.”* Contemplating the *“ocean depths”* of this mystery can make us humans feel so small, and almighty God so far from us. Yet nothing could be further from the truth as today’s readings demonstrate.

In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that God is intimately connected to us. *“The love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.”* God wants to live in the very depths of our being and in all the intimate details of our lives if we will let Him.

And in the Gospel from St. John, we learn that God holds back nothing of Himself from us. Jesus tells His disciples (this includes us!) that the Holy Spirit *“will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything the Father has is mine.”* Thus, we find ourselves drawn right into the midst of this Trinitarian love. In fact, if the mystery of Holy Trinity is an ocean which to swim, the *“water”* that makes up that ocean is love.

What then should be the response of the Christian steward to this sublime mystery? All we can do is worship. And offer our lives back to God in total gratitude for calling us to live in the richness of such unfathomable love.

History of the Mary Queen of Peace Shrine

My name is Mary Ann Huber. I am the wife of William and mother of 4 children, Kevin, Karen, Kathy and Kim.

The shrine's beginning started August 15, 1985—the Feast of the Assumption. While I was at Mass, for some unknown reason thoughts flashed through my mind of a shrine to be located at the corner of Civic Park Drive and Imperial Drive. I sometimes have difficulty concentrating, so I immediately dismissed them and finished Mass properly. But after coming home, I instinctively grabbed a paper and began to draw an "L" shaped structure. My thoughts were very clear. There were to be no water fountains and 3 steps



each measuring 2 feet in height. The total height was to be 30 feet.

There was to be a roof. I started to draw a conventional square roof but thoughts of several lines were drawn which I couldn't make sense of until the last one was completed. Then a star could be clearly seen and it was over. I still remember the strange feelings I had. I would never have thought of a star for a roof of a shrine. What IS this??? I had never heard of locutions. I just knew I had never experienced anything like this. Perhaps it was all my imagination. After all I didn't even own the ground. I certainly didn't have any money to finance this project. Maybe I could just forget it and no one would ever know.

Ultimately, I did what I really felt I was supposed to do. The ground went up for sale shortly after and we quickly purchased it, contracted a subdivision, sold lots and named it Coronation Heights in honor of Mary's Coronation and she would be high on a hill. A non-profit corporation was formed and

Lot 1 was donated to the Mary Queen of Peace Shrine. I see the shrine as Mary calling all her children, all races, all creeds and all ages to bring them to her son, Jesus. There are many who do not come to a church. My hope is that, like a magnet, they will be attracted to her in times of difficulty, stress or whatever the need. She will, in turn, point to her son, Jesus of Mercy, who is the ultimate emphasis.

Literally hundreds of people have responded to the requests of labor, equipment and financial assistance. People have donated to garage sales, an auction, a cookie factory booth, ticket sales and raffles. Lists of these donators have been carefully recorded and are available on request. The bottom line is that many people built this shrine. Those who have responded must feel a great deal of pride and satisfaction to be involved in such a worthy endeavor.
