Hello,

This weekend we have a missionary preaching at all of the masses, Fr. Mansuetus Setonga. The following is some information that he sent to let us know a little bit more about him and some of his work:

Father Mansuetus Setonga is a priest in the Diocese of Same, Tanzania, Africa. Ordained in 1986, Father Setonga has held the following positions of Diocesan leadership.

Rector of Chanjale Minor Seminary - 1986 to 1989.

General Secretary of the Diocese of Same - 1989 to 1994, 2000 to 2010.

Director of Mater Dei Africa - May 2014 to present.

Advanced Studies,

St. Cloud State University (1994 - 1997) - MS Public Administration 1997

University of Iowa (1997 - 2000) - MS Economic Development 2000

University of Iowa (2010 - 2013) - studies toward a PhD in Economic Development

Mater Dei Africa was formed as a result of reflection by its founder, Father Setonga, while pursuing his Doctoral Degree in Economic Development while studying at the University of Iowa. The mission of Mater Dei Africa (MDA) is to transform the lives of the poor, including elderly people and vulnerable children, by providing integrated family care and community-based services to enable them to become self-reliant and productive members of society, both economically and socially.

During his years of service in the Diocese of Same, Father Setonga implemented and managed dozens of innovative poverty alleviation programs to assist the many and diverse people of northeastern Tanzania, including Pare and Maasai, Catholic, Muslim, and traditional religions.

In May 2018, Rt. Rev. Rogath Kimaryo the Ordinary of the Diocese of Same received the request from Fr. Mansuetus Setonga to establish a Religious Congregation "The Sisters of Mater Dei Africa". Bishop Rt. Rev. Kimaryo approved the instituting of a diocesan Sisters' Congregation and to be formed by the neighboring Sisters of Mary of Kakamega, Kenya as a way of addressing the pastoral needs of the Diocese of Same.

The Sisters of Mater Dei Africa are housed in a recently constructed convent which is now fully occupied but lack a healthy water supply. Currently the Postulates carry 18-liters of water one mile from the only local water source, a river that is shared by both people and animals. The river source is not a clean healthy water supply which is used by the convent members and local villagers for drinking, washing, and cooking. As a result, many of these people including the several convent members suffer from diarrhea, typhoid and other water borne diseases.

Accordingly, Father Setonga is bringing forward this request to you, to assist in raising \$28,000 to drill a local water well near the convent to serve the members of the convent and neighboring village.

God Bless you for your assistance.

A second collection will be taken today to assist Fr. Setonga and his work. Like the Good Samaritan who we heard of in the Gospel just a few weeks ago, now that we have heard and our hearts have recognized the needs of the Sisters of Mater Dei Africa we realize that they also are our neighbors, and we are to respond to their needs out of love.

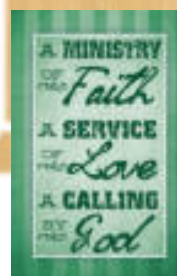

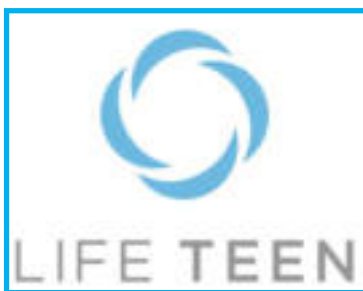


Assumption Blood Drive – August 2nd!

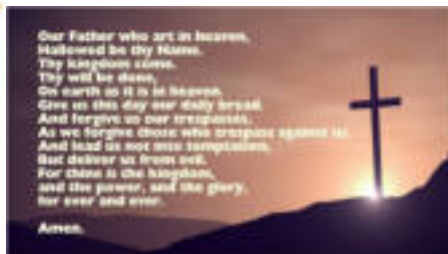

In our Gospel

reading from Luke, some disciples of Jesus ask our Lord to teach them how to pray. Jesus instantly offers them the beautiful prayer which we, of course, call the Our Father.

The Our Father is truly a steward's prayer. In it, we call upon God in an intimate way, as Father. We ask that His will be done (not ours!) and that His kingdom come (not ours!). In other words, we remember that He is our Creator, everything is His, and our focus in life should be on His priorities, not our own. Then we ask Him to supply our needs (to give our daily bread), forgive our sins, and protect us from evil. That is, we proclaim our complete trust in His provision for us and mercy towards us. We, too, commit to extending mercy ourselves (as we forgive those who sin against us).

As we pray the words of the Our Father, we recognize this basic truth about ourselves and God: God is our Father, and we are beloved and infinitely blessed to be His children. This is the basis of a stewardship way of life.

At the end of the Gospel passage, Jesus encourages us to pursue a relationship with the Father: Ask Him, seek Him, knock on His door!

He can hardly wait to bless us, His children. Remember that this week, then go, be a blessing to others! *Stewardship is just that simple.*
