

Hello,

I don't know if you noticed, but last week and this upcoming week we have numerous saints' days that were founders of religious orders. Sunday, July 31st, we had St. Ignatius of Loyola who founded the Jesuits,



St. Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1556) founded the Society of Jesus, or the Jesuits. Wounded in battle as a Spanish soldier he had a spiritual conversion and decided to devote his life to God. Spending a year in extreme ascetic practices, he had mystical experiences that would be the basis for his book *Spiritual Exercises* that became the foundational guide for the Jesuits and used by many in leading retreats. Studying at the University of Paris he would gather other students who would go with him to Rome to found the Jesuits. They would soon found many universities, go out to the world as missionaries, and be recognized as leaders in the Counter-Reformation, spreading the faithful teachings of the Catholic faith.

St. Alphonsus Ligouri (1696-1787) founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, or the Redemptorists. He was a lawyer at the age of 17 and practiced without losing a case for eight years. Then when he lost a case by an oversight on his part he took it as a sign from God that he was to leave that profession to become a priest. Known for his analytic and precise mind he could also be very scrupulous, but knew that in treating others he should be merciful and compassionate. In his book *Moral Theology*, in his preaching, and in his modest life he strived to seek a balance; avoiding riches and self-indulgences of some while also avoiding the rigorism of the Jansenists. At his first attempt at establishing the Redemptorists, within the first months all of those who had started abandoned him but one. However, others soon came and the order would grow and continues today.

St. Dominic (1170-1221) founded the Order of Preachers, or the Dominicans. Unlike Ignatius and Alphonsus, Dominic was raised to dedicate his life to the Church and to be a priest. On a trip traveling through southern France where the heresy of Albigensianism or Catharism was strong, he is said to have converted the Cathar whose house he was staying in by having a long discussion into the night. Pope Innocent III would approve the founding of the Dominican order to preach throughout various territories in opposition to heresies.

St. Jane Francis de Chantal (1572-1641) founded the Congregation of the Visitation of the Virgin Mary, or the Visitation order. She married Christophe de Rabutin, baron de Chantal, when she was 20 and would later have six children. The first three died soon after birth and then her husband died in 1601. St. Francis de Sales was her spiritual director and while she was considering entering the Carmelite order he convinced her to start a new order. These women would not be cloistered and open for those who may not be accepted in other orders, and would work in the community. The local Church wasn't ready for that

yet, but obviously St. Jane did travel as she founded up to 65 convents by 1635.




