
### Hello.

Save the date for the evening of Monday, Oct. 10<sup>th</sup> or Wednesday, Oct. 12<sup>th</sup> from 6 to 8pm to join us for our All Things New Fall Listening Sessions. At these sessions you will be given a first-hand look at three proposed models for the parishes in our planning area, Number 10, shown below. The purpose of the listening sessions is to share proposed planning area models, and then to gather your input on these proposed options so that a recommendation can be presented to Archbishop Rozanski for his discernment.

On August 19th the priests of the archdiocese were shown proposed parish models for each of the 15 different planning areas throughout the archdiocese and provided feedback. This feedback is being incorporated and next week parish representatives from each of the parishes in our planning area will gather to hear about the updated proposed parish models for our planning area, to discuss them, and provide feedback. These models will then be updated and this will be presented by a trained facilitator at our parish listening sessions. At each of the sessions, parishioners will be provided the information needed to voice their concerns and comments outside of these listening sessions through an openended survey about the parish's model options. This feedback will be incorporated into revised models which will be refined with input from the pastors and key parish leaders throughout the winter 2022 and into 2023. While decisions will be made in spring 2023, implementation will not begin until fall 2023 and will extend through 2026.
