



I might get distracted looking through past Christmas cards I've received or photos from past Christmases and be reminded of what I'm looking forward to. I could be rushing to put up decorations that I haven't managed to get completed, so I and others can be helped to be in the festive holiday spirit.

You can support Catholic schools with a full credit against your state income tax!

Did you know that up to half of your state income tax liability can help families attend Catholic schools? For every dollar given to the MOScholars program, you'll pay one dollar less to Jefferson City, not to exceed 50% of your tax liability. So, if you expect to owe \$3,000 in state taxes, you can donate up to \$1,500 and get a tax credit for that amount.

Here's how it works in 3 simple steps:

2. Submit your tax credit authorization, along with your donation, within 30 days to TTEF. Upon receipt, they will send you a tax credit certificate for the full value of your donation.

3. When you **file your state taxes** for 2022, include the tax credit certificate you received to reduce your tax liability by the amount of the donation you made!

Gifts to the MOScholars program through the TTEF will be used to provide scholarships to students attending eligible Catholic schools, including Assumption, based on their family's income level or the child's learning requirements.

Any individual or entity with a state tax liability can participate. This is an incredible year-end tax planning strategy!

December 18, 2022 – Fourth Sunday in Advent IS 7:10-14, 10; PS 24:1-6; ROM 1:1-7; MT 1:18-24

As our Advent preparations draw to a close and Christmas fast approaches, it is fitting that today's readings demonstrate the intensity of the Father's perfect and passionate love for each of us, culminating in the gift of His own Son, Jesus Christ, on Christmas Day.

In response to such an overwhelming gift, what can we do except

offer our lives as gift in return, embracing a stewardship way of life with all the love and strength we have to give?

In our Gospel passage from Matthew, we find an unparalleled example of one who embraced this way of life in St. Joseph, as he obeys God's call to him through the message of an angel.

We never hear St. Joseph speak, but the Scriptures tell us he was always listening, attentive to the leading of the Holy Spirit for his family. It was Joseph who found the stable where the baby Jesus would be born. No doubt it was Joseph who cleaned it up and prepared it for Mary and Jesus since we know that Mary was about to give birth. Joseph protected the family, guarded them, and tended to their safety, their comfort, and their well-being at the expense of his own plans and preferences. Though we do not hear any words from St. Joseph his actions clearly show that he offered himself, his whole life, as a gift to his family through his strong guidance, protection, and service.

Let us imitate St. Joseph, then, as good stewards, giving our very lives to those around us in love and gratitude to God, who has given us everything we have, especially His own Son, Jesus Christ.




Happy Advent from Assumption Youth Ministry!
