*Hello and Happy Father's Day to all Fathers,*



I don't know if you were aware or not, but after the long Easter time, and the special feasts of the Ascension, Pentecost, The Holy Trinity, and Corpus Christi, we have now found ourselves back in ordinary time. Often we can see this in a negative sense, no longer in our periods of celebration, but this year in particular I think we are looking at it a bit differently. Going to 'ordinary time' is something we are looking forward to as we are hopefully coming out of this pandemic.

Every year when we come back to ordinary times is a period when we are hopefully settling back into our normal ways and daily lives. This is something we have all been looking forward to after the separation and isolation that we have had to practice over these past 15 months. We need to not only reestablish our old patterns, but also consider if there are beneficial things that we need to continue from this period ('COVID Keeps' I've heard them called), or something new I've been inspired to maybe start doing now.

As the archbishop is lifting the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass (that means you are obliged to go again), hopefully this is one of our old patterns we will reestablish. I have been glad to see our Masses becoming more crowded again, with someone every week telling me that this is their first time back, and hopefully we can continue to welcome more back in the coming weeks. Please let me or others know if we can do something to relieve any concerns you may have about the spread of COVID at our Masses.

A possible 'COVID Keep' is the projection of readings and hymns on the wall during Masses. Hymnals are now available in the Narthex. Depending on how this goes we will consider if we purchase hymnals for all the pews in the future or just some for those who choose to use it, with the projected words for others. We also consider that we will be keeping hand sanitizer around at the entrances to church. Personally, I know I am hoping to keep the practices of some communications I have been doing better since COVID. Have you possibly developed a good prayer practice, regular communications with God, that can be kept as you go back to ordinary times?

As we ramp up the different ministries at Mass you might consider if you may be called to participate in something new. Lectors, choir, extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist, ushers/greeters? Maybe scheduling a time for Eucharistic Adoration? I'm looking at how we might expand our children's Liturgy of the Word, maybe you would be able to assist with this?



## Coronavirus Dispensation Lifted

### Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski Invites the Faithful Back to Mass.

As the world moves forward on the path of healing, we invite everybody in the Archdiocese of St. Louis to gather together again to experience the Eucharist—the true presence of the Body of Christ—in its fullest form. On July 1, 2021, Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski will lift the dispensation of the obligation to attend Sunday Mass for all of the faithful in the Archdiocese of St. Louis—meaning that we will all be called to return to Holy Mass in person each Sunday. (Archbishop Rozanski has made a video inviting us all back to Mass in the following link: <https://youtu.be/dCYuyopNEVM>)

To accommodate the needs and concerns of all our parishioners Assumption is updating our safety protocols and other liturgical directives as follows:

- Those fully vaccinated are no longer required to wear masks in the church.
- Those not fully vaccinated are asked to please wear masks except for when they are receiving the Eucharist.
- Part of the church will still have every other pew blocked for those who desire to continue the full 6 ft. social distancing.
- Baptismal Font and Holy Water dishes will be filled
- Prayers, scripture readings, and music lyrics will still be projected, but Breaking Bread Missals will also be available as you enter the church.
- We will begin passing the Offertory baskets again on July 4th
- The Sign of Peace is reinstated, but with no physical contact
- Distribution of the Precious Blood remains suspended until further notice
- Parishioners who are sick, homebound, immunocompromised and gravely concerned for their health retain the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass, which has always been the case in normal times. Though we should take the obligation to attend Mass seriously, no one is ever morally obligated to do something that would jeopardize their health or the health of other people.

### June 20, 2021-Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

*JB 38:1, 8-11; PS 107:23-24, 24-26, 28-29, 30-31; 2 COR 5:14-17; MK 4:35-41*

Our readings today remind us that God always has our best interests in mind. No matter what is going on in our lives, God is with us.

In our Gospel today, Jesus and His disciples are traveling in a boat when heavy winds and violent waves begin to overwhelm the boat.

Jesus was there sleeping in the boat during this horrific storm.

The disciples woke Jesus and questioned Him, "***Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?***" Jesus calms the wind and the waves, and then asks them in return, "***Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?***"

Think back to a time that you endured great suffering, a hard trial or felt overwhelmed with life. How did you respond?

In moments of trial, we often live our days in a panic. We see the water coming into our boat and we do all that we can in our power to stay afloat. We are frantic, so we fail to stop and recognize that our Savior is in the same boat with us. Although it might feel like He is sleeping and His presence is lacking, He is right there suffering with us.

God will not allow anything that we cannot handle. In a moment of suffering, we might feel trapped. Yet, He sees the moment of peace and still waters.

During our trials, cling to Jesus. Know that there is an end, and whether we see the end in this life or the next, God allows it all for our salvation. Today, let us thank God for His presence in our lives, and ask for the eyes of faith to see that He is right here with us always.




