## Hello,



This summer seems to be a bit more of a ‘summer’ than most years, hopefully in a good way. A time when we can take a vacation and be a bit more at ease after the many months of the pandemic and are able to relax and reinvigorate. We still need to be cautious and aware for ourselves and for others, but hopefully able to interact with others much more freely than we have for the last 16 months.

With this opening up and somewhat getting back to normal I know myself, and many others, are wanting to just rush back into some things the way we used to do. However, we need to take a moment to be sure if that is best for ourselves and for others. We have all changed a bit over this period, hopefully we can say we’ve ‘grown’ in some positive ways. Maybe instead of just going back to how we had done things, we can do them better. Or, maybe instead of what I had been doing before, would it be better if I made a change moving on to something else now?

Just at Mass in the parish we are bringing back servers, having two lectors instead of only one at many Masses again, having more Eucharistic Ministers (as we are fortunately having more people at Mass – although we will still not be distributing the Precious Blood), and our choir will be coming back too. The servers had a training camp for both new and old ones, refreshing the experienced ones and letting them know some of the things we might have changed a little, while having them there to also help the new ones learn and gain confidence in their ministry. So with many of the other ministries at Mass, consider if you are going to come back to a ministry you’ve done before, or maybe consider getting involved in something you hadn’t done before.

You probably noticed that we have hymnals now on a cart coming into Mass, but we don’t have them in every pew like we used to. This is because many have commented that they prefer having the music and readings projected, so not everyone needs a hymnal. But, some prefer using the hymnal itself for these texts, or to follow with other parts of the Mass that are not projected. The other reason the hymnals are not back in every pew is that we didn’t buy enough last year to fill every pew. That saved some money and now, over the next month or two, we can figure out how we want to go forward for next year.

Those are just some examples at Mass. In our Pastoral Planning for the parish we are looking at other ways we have all identified we want to grow. I know the Athletic Association has new leadership and are looking for more people. We are looking at reinvigorating a Men’s group, the Grounds and Gardening Committee, and other groups in the parish. I know The Knights of Columbus reopened their hall after major renovations only recently before the pandemic and are looking at reinvigorating their membership.

As we go through this summer, and hopefully are reinvigorated as society can open up, let’s not just go back to how we were, but see what we can become. Peace,

## Coronavirus Dispensation Lifted

### Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski Invites the Faithful Back to Mass.

As the world moves forward on the path of healing, we invite everybody in the Archdiocese of St. Louis to gather together again to experience the Eucharist—the true presence of the Body of Christ—in its fullest form. On July 1, 2021, Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski will lift the dispensation of the obligation to attend Sunday Mass for all of the faithful in the Archdiocese of St. Louis—meaning that we will all be called to return to Holy Mass in person each Sunday. (Archbishop Rozanski has made a video inviting us all back to Mass in the following link: <https://youtu.be/dCYuyopNEVM>)

To accommodate the needs and concerns of all our parishioners Assumption is updating our safety protocols and other liturgical directives as follows:

- Those fully vaccinated are no longer required to wear masks in the church.
- Those not fully vaccinated are asked to please wear masks except for when they are receiving the Eucharist.
- Part of the church will still have every other pew blocked for those who desire to continue the full 6 ft. social distancing.
- Baptismal Font and Holy Water dishes will be filled
- Prayers, scripture readings, and music lyrics will still be projected, but Breaking Bread Missals will also be available as you enter the church.
- We will begin passing the Offertory baskets again on July 4th
- The Sign of Peace is reinstated, but with no physical contact
- Distribution of the Precious Blood remains suspended until further notice
- Parishioners who are sick, homebound, immunocompromised and gravely concerned for their health retain the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass, which has always been the case in normal times. Though we should take the obligation to attend Mass seriously, no one is ever morally obligated to do something that would jeopardize their health or the health of other people.

## PRESSING INTO JESUS



MARK 5:21-43

**June 27, 2021**

**Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

WIS 1:13-15, 2:23-24; PS 30:2, 4, 5-6, 11, 12, 13; 2 COR 8:7, 9, 13-15; MK 5:21-43 OR 5:21-24, 35b-43

Our readings today remind us that our God is a tender and loving God.

In our Gospel, Jesus heals an ill child. An anxious and loving father sought after Jesus so that his daughter might be cured of her illness. As Jesus was traveling to heal her, they got word that the daughter had died. In that deeply painful moment, a moment no parent wants to experience, Jesus turned and said, *"Do not be afraid; just have faith."*

Recall a moment when you felt like you hit rock bottom. Maybe you received devastating news, someone died, you lost your job, you were fighting addiction, or you were suffering mentally, spiritually, or physically. Maybe you are living that moment or maybe that moment is yet to come.

In that time, imagine Jesus looking at you and saying, *"Do not be afraid; just have faith."* Remember this verse. May it bring you peace and comfort. Recall that in our First Reading, God does not rejoice in our suffering and death. He rejoices in our faith and our trust in His glorious plan for our lives.

Whether we are healed like the little girl in our Gospel in this life, or we carry our suffering with us until we reach the next, if we remain faithful, Jesus will one day say to us, *"Little girl or little boy, I say to you, arise!"*

Today, let us reflect on how much our Good and Gracious God loves us. Remember that whatever we are suffering in this life, do not be afraid, God is right there with us.






