

Hello,

I just got back from vacation Monday evening and I noticed how nice our landscaping looked. I also have to thank numerous others for while I was gone, especially our office staff and particularly Monsignor McCumber. Both Fr. Patrick and I were gone for most of last week, yet things managed to keep going and I know I managed to have a relaxing vacation.

It is good to be reminded that just because we are gone for a few days, the world doesn't come to a stop. Things were being taken care of before we got here and will be after we go. That doesn't mean that what we do isn't important, and that I didn't have a stack of things waiting for me when I got back, but it also helps to keep in perspective that no matter who we are, we don't have to and don't do everything ourselves. That we are not being forced to do things because we have to, that we are making choices. There were some things that we identified that we had to keep going, but many that we realized we didn't or might have been forced to realize were not as important as we had thought before. For all of us, hopefully, we realize how much more we do depend upon one another and are supported by others. As I ended my vacation, as we are hopefully coming out of the worst of COVID, it is a good opportunity to be grateful for all that others do around us. To realize that we are not doing things on our own. It is also a good time to put things back into perspective and realize that whatever we do, we are making choices to do it. To not let circumstances around us overwhelm us, and to always consciously make our choices in line with our beliefs and our faith.


