Hello,



Every year we try to do something to celebrate our parish feast day, the Feast of the Assumption, and this being our 150th year we are

really celebrating it . We have music, food trucks, tours of our church, chapel and school.as The Knights of Columbus Hall is celebrating their 100th anniversary and had Archbishop Rozanski out to celebrate Mass with us last night.

Of course every year we have the opportunity to celebrate Mass together on our feast day, and for our parish the Feast of the Assumption also happens to be a holy day of obligation. But this year we get the extra special fact that it falls on Sunday.

A core aspect of all these celebrations we are talking about is that they are centered around us gathering as a community of people, and that is what a parish is. A parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor. Also, as a general rule, a parish is to be territorial. (Canons 515 & 518) One of the key things we can see from this is that a parish, while in a certain geographical territory, isn't the land or the buildings, but it is the people, the community in that territory.

While we recognize the church buildings we gather in to worship, and the school where our children learn, it is the people that matter. Looking at our chapel we are grateful for the people who helped provide for this place to gather and worship God. We think of those who have received the sacraments there, and recall our celebrating of those sacraments. Our church is a building that many of you have had a part in its construction, and have provided a place for our continual sacramental life as we also look forward to the future. The school began as soon as our parish did, 150 years ago, and continues to provide a place for our children to learn. As we recognize the many different changes its building has gone through over these many years, we also consider the generations that have gone through the doors.

Another point you may have noted about a parish is that it is supposed to be stable. At 150 years I think we have made a good start on that. Actually just looking over some different information today I first put together the facts that while our parish was named after the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary back in 1871, the Assumption was only declared as a dogma of the Catholic Church in 1950 by Pope Pius XII in the Apostolic Constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*. Obviously, even though it had not been declared infallibly by the Pope yet, Mary's Assumption was already an integral part of our faith.

I hope you are able to come up and celebrate with us this weekend as well as throughout this month of our anniversary. And I look forward to celebrating with you as we continue as a parish for years to come.

<u>August 15, 2021 – Solemnity of the Assumption of the</u> Blessed Virgin Mary

RV 11:19A, 12:1-6A, 10AB; PS 45:10, 11, 12, 16; 1 COR 15:20-27; LK 1:39-56

Today we celebrate the Assumption of Mary — the moment she was taken up, body and soul, into heaven. This day reveals much about our Holy Mother. Next to her Divine Son, Mary truly is the model steward for us as we journey through this life.

Our Gospel recounts the story of Mary visiting her cousin Elizabeth who

was soon to deliver John the Baptist. Mary truly is a dwelling place for Christ. Even baby John the Baptist noticed as he leaped in his mother's womb upon Mary's greeting! We too are called to be a dwelling place for the Lord. Yet for Christ to dwell in us, we must prepare our hearts for Him.

Mary was prepared for Christ to reside in her, and her Magnificat expresses how we can imitate her and prepare a place for Christ in ourselves: *"My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord..."*

How can we proclaim the 'greatness of the Lord?' It is simply by how we choose to live our lives. Each day is an opportunity to grow as a disciple of Christ. We can choose to rise each day in prayer, respond to those around us in kindness, serve in our vocations and occupations from a place of love and selflessness, and use our gifts and talents for the glory of God.

As we reflect on the life of Mary today, let us strive to imitate her in proclaiming the greatness of God by how we live our lives. Let us celebrate her as our Mother, our Queen, and a Model Steward. She is not distant or out of reach, rather, she is as close to us as a mother to her baby — constantly watching, interceding, and guiding us to be with her Divine Son in eternal life.


