

Blood Drive – Thank You! Thank You! Thank You!



Celebrate! As we begin our 150th year, we are blessed with 149 years behind us and a great future ahead of us. Our 2021-2022 theme for the year is "Celebrate" – taking each day, each moment to rejoice in what we have been given, enjoying each person we encounter, and developing a community where we inspire each other to bring Christ to the world.

Teachers Prepare for 21-22

Each year, Assumption faculty prepare for the new year by attending a three day orientation. This year, our faculty was introduced to the Danielson Faculty Formation Program, sponsored by the Archdiocese. Developing teachers to their fullest potential is the goal of the program, and both administration and teachers collaborate to review the teachers' goals for improvement in teaching. The Danielson Framework for Teaching was developed by Charlotte Danielson and is used worldwide for growth in knowledge and understanding of best practices in teaching.

Assumption Pilots Program with Nationally known Educator

In Spring, 2021, Dr. Hensley became familiar with Heidi Hayes Jacobs, a nationally known educator and author in the area of curriculum development.

"UbD" or Understanding by Design, is a framework for improving student achievement emphasizing the teacher's critical role as a designer of learning. Teachers learn to clarify learning goals, devise assessments of student understanding and craft effective and engaging learning activities.

When Dr. Hensley met with the Archdiocesan Curriculum Coordinator, Maureen Lovette, the two spoke of creating a pilot program, whereby Assumption (and a few other schools) would

pilot this framework and begin the process of developing lesson plans. Assumption's faculty will be trained by Heidi Hayes Jacobs on October 1, our first Professional Development Day to learn this process.

Graduate Honors Wall

Having had the pleasure of knowing three graduating classes, it was decided that we need to begin notably identifying those who achieved honors at graduation. In thinking about this, we determined that the entrance wall would be ideal. Over the summer, all of the components were designed and placed by Mr. Steve Quan.
